

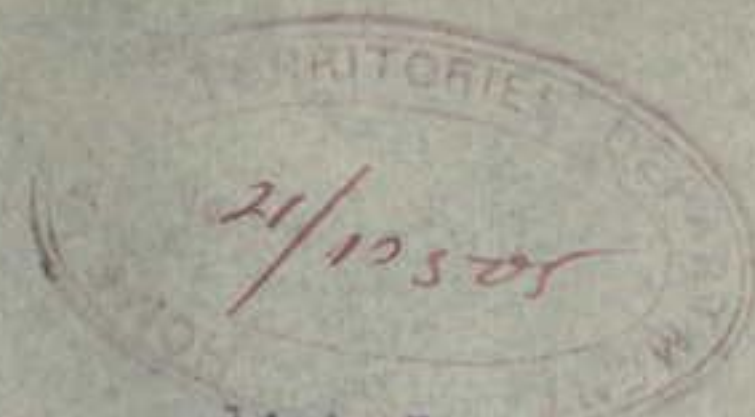



Dear Mr Quinlan,

There is no helio of the plan of the Mission Lands. When Harper made his survey, the Mission lands had already been granted, and helios were only made from Harper's plans.

The original survey was made by the Sappers and Miners shortly after the arrival of the Pitcairn Islanders in 1856. It was from this plan that the Mission deeds were prepared. That plan is now on the island at the Court House, but I think it should be kept at Head Quarters in Melbourne, unless the Administrator should happen to be a Surveyor.

Harper's original plans of the helios you already have are also on the island in a large portfolio, for a similar reason they should also be filed at Head Quarters.

So also should all the old Field Books which are in the Administrator's Office, but which probably will never be referred to, It is suggested that you should send for them.

I have a copy of the old map somewhere. I will look it up. The original plan I refer to is a large plan in a tin case, it was going to rack and ruin and I brought it to Sydney recently and had it repaired. Stephenson knows the plan as I particularly called his attention to it on my last inspection of his papers.

The Standard tracings of the helios I left with Carrodus, are in the Lands Dept. They should be applied for and kept in the Dept. of Home and Territories. I will see Mr Keating in the meantime, he is the Under Secretary and a personal friend of mine.

I am trying to get a copy of the old laws etc from Govt. House here for Carrodus' information.

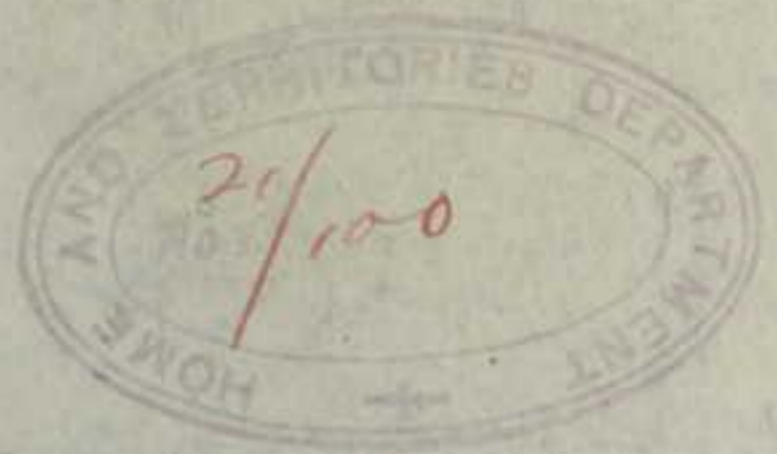

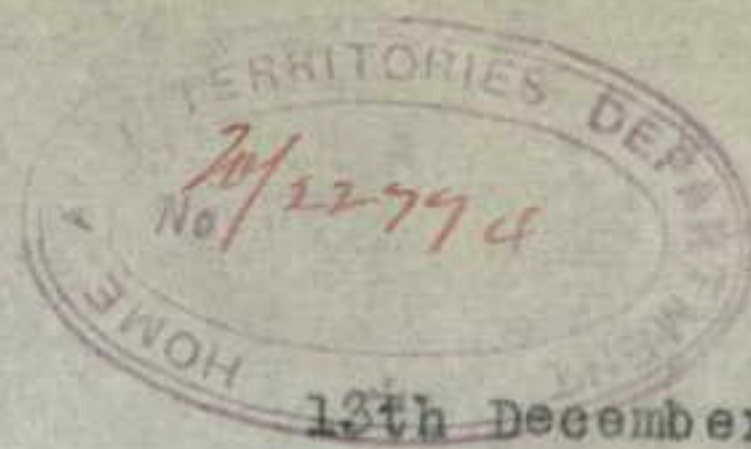

Land leases - Norfolk Island.
