Dear Sir, Estimates 1925/6.

In view of requirements of the Royal Commissioner, I have had a series of photographs taken of Government buildings at Norfolk Island, and I am forwarding you copies, which will serve to illustrate the work I have done here in the last 18 months, more particularly in the last 9 months.

I regret I did not have photographs taken of the properties before I commenced on them, but I have endeavored to give you some idea of their condition by the photos I now include of the Govt Store and of House No 3, which has recently fallen in from a Licence, I can only describe the general condition as most deplorable. By my restoration and renovation they have all been turned into first class properties, a credit to any Government, and a long life has been given to buildings which, without attention would, in the course of a few years, have fallen into a ruinous condition. I have made notes on the back of each which will have the effect of identifying each sub item of Item No 1.

Memorandum to the Right Honorable the Minister  
HOME & TERRITORIES DEPARTMENT  
MELBOURNE.

Herewith I have the honor to enclose a number of photographs of the surroundings of Government House, Norfolk Island, for your information, and to enable you to judge as to the ruinous condition of the outhouses and walls of this property, and the serious need there is for renovation or demolition. This course suggested itself to me when I saw what could be done at a small expense, after the new Post Office had been rescued from decay, and turned into a solid building good for many years, and I regretted I had not obtained a photograph of it, before alteration was made. For the information of the Department also, I forward prints, which serve to show what can be produced in the short time I have had at my disposal, these are illuminating and instructive, and will serve to show the lines on which I am dealing with the question of what the land will produce, by means of an object lesson; I trust you will approve the principle on which I am working.

At the Annual Show, which was held to day, I staged an Exhibit of Vegetables actually grown by me, without any adventitious aid, in the shape of Fertiliser, it created considerable interest, and I have good reason to believe, will give results. If the photograph of this exhibit is completed in time for this mail, I will include it.
